Why Communion Every Week @ FCC?

At Communion, Christians meditate upon the sacrifice of Jesus for their salvation. They examine themselves to ascertain if they have grown in the grace and knowledge of Christ during the past week. They reaffirm their covenant with God: to love Him with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength. Communion is the only way Jesus Himself asked to be remembered. Let us come together on this Lord's Day and every Lord's Day to remember and celebrate His mercy in the Lord's Supper as we commune together.

Do you want to be right with God and have a fresh start?

The solution is as simple as ABC:

A: *Admit* that you have sinned and need a Savior.

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)

B: *Believe* that God loves you and gave His Son for your salvation.

"While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

C: *Confess* your faith in Jesus, repenting of your sins and being baptized.

"Repent...be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38)
